2024 Year in Review

Founder Network

This year, UVC developed a more structured way of delivering services and measuring outcomes to the 650+ high growth companies tracked in Upstate NY. Founders have access to peers and UVC's deep network of experts, investors, and service providers. Members gain unique opportunities to engage throughout the year and access UVC's 20K strong national community of supporters.

Unleashed Retreat, Founder Fusions, & UNY50 Gatherings

UVC continues its strategy of hosting invite-only gatherings for new and experienced founders. We thoughtfully curate each get-together to deepen relationships. Our flagship event, Unleashed Founders Retreat is an invitation-only retreat allowing founders to relax in an unplugged environment while building connections with some of the most successful entrepreneurs of today and the next generation of unicorn CEOs.

Community Advocate Program

This year we expanded our Community Advocate Program, bringing on advocates in the Rochester and CNY/Mohawk Valley regions. These individuals are our localized presence in regional ecosystems - responsible for engaging local founders and bringing them into the UVC network for more connectivity. Due to the success of these two regions, we are expanding the program in 2025 to include both the Capital Region and Southern Tier.










2024 Metrics


2024 Founder Engagement






High Growth Company Database State-Wide Snapshot

Impact by region: WNY






Impact by region: Finger Lakes


Impact by region: CNY, Mohawk Valley, North Country

Impact by region: Southern Tier






Impact by region: Capital Region & Mid-Hudson

Unleashed Founders Retreat

This year's retreat gave founders a chance to step back from the day-to-day chaos of entrepreneurial life, reflect on broader strategic challenges, and connect with fellow Upstate New York founders. Founders enjoyed an unplugged environment while building connections with successful entrepreneurs and the next generation of unicorn CEOs.

The 48 hour retreat featured small group conversations, curated networking, and activities that lent themselves to fostering relationships. The retreat also celebrated the Upstate startup community through annual awards. The 2024 Deal of the Year recipient was Nuvalence's acquisition by EY. Community Catalyst Awardees were presented to Noa Simons, CEO & Cofounder of Good Bread and Peter Dean, CEO & Founder of RenderTribe.

Network Building Outside Upstate

Upstate New York has a growing tech economy that is still invisible to the broader public. New founders need visibility and connectivity to access experienced mentors, advisors and investors. UVC has developed a new series of events called "Founder Fusion," which is about bringing together entrepreneurs and emerging founders from Upstate NY with other networks and communities.

These curated events are designed to foster meaningful connections, facilitate valuable discussions, and pave the way for collaborative opportunities. UVC Founder Fusion events bring top notch speakers including co-founders of Wayfair, GLG, The Laundress, and more.


