Letter from the CEO

Dear Community Partners:

When I look back on 2025, the word that comes to mind is momentum. Upstate Venture Connect was created to do one thing exceptionally well: connect people and ideas in a way that helps high-growth founders succeed without requiring them to leave Upstate New York to do it. This year, that mission felt more tangible than ever.

In 2025, we doubled down on what makes UVC special: curated relationships, founder-first programming, and a deeply human approach to ecosystem building. We focused on depth, trust, and outcomes and our results speak for themselves.

At the core of UVC is our founder community. This year, we expanded and activated our network of experienced entrepreneurs (UNY50) across the region and beyond. What continues to inspire me is how generous this community is. Founders who have exited are showing up to mentor first-time CEOs. Operators are making warm introductions without expecting anything in return. That give-first culture is the heartbeat of UVC.

In 2025, we leaned into experiential programming as a strategic tool not just for inspiration, but for tangible outcomes. Our first event Founder Fusion roadshows brought 14 Upstate founders into rooms they wouldn't otherwise have access to: with investors, corporate partners, and industry leaders in DC. This proved a much needed model for our founders to expand their connectivity and bring it back home and allowed us to do 4 more in 2026.


One of the most meaningful evolutions at UVC this year was the continued growth of our Community Advocate program. We expanded a boots-on-the-ground model that empowers trusted local leaders to act as connectors, scouts, and champions in their regions. These advocates are the reason we're seeing stronger founder referrals, deeper regional engagement, and more inclusive access to UVC's network. This model is becoming a blueprint for how ecosystem building can scale without losing its soul.

None of this work happens in isolation. To our donors, sponsors, and partners: thank you for trusting us and standing behind this mission. To our board and advisors: thank you for your steady guidance and belief in what we're building. And to the founders: thank you for taking the risk. UVC exists because of you.

2025 Year in Review

FOUNDER NETWORK & UNY50

This year, UVC made more founder referrals than ever before: **545**. Founders in our network have access to peers and UVC's deep network of experts, investors, and service providers. We also expanded our founder programming to include travel to regions outside of the state, such as the Founder Roadshow: Upstate to DC. UVC also made a concerted effort to identify more UNY50 members, increasing membership from 50 to 61 members.

UNLEASHED RETREAT, FOUNDER FUSIONS, SPECIAL EVENTS

UVC continues its strategy of hosting invite-only gatherings for new and experienced founders. We thoughtfully curate each get-together to deepen relationships. In addition to our flagship event, the Unleashed Founders Retreat, UVC hosted a sold-out Upstate Founders Fete in February, welcomed Brad Feld to Upstate NY in June, and hosted an NYC Founder Fusion and CEO Dinner during NY Tech Week.

COMMUNITY ADVOCATE PROGRAM

This year we expanded our Community Advocate Program, bringing on advocates in the Capital Region and Southern Tier in addition to the Rochester and CNY/Mohawk Valley regions. These individuals are our localized presence in regional ecosystems, responsible for engaging local founders and bringing them into the UVC network for more connectivity. In 2026, we will be expanding again into the Hudson Valley.















in 2025, UVC honed in on not only on finding expats with Upstate ties, but on bringing Upstate founders to different geographies to network and further their company's growth.

Through Springboard funding from the Ralph C. Wilson Jr. Foundation, UVC launched the Upstate to DC Founders Roadshow in 2025, connecting startups with national investors and federal innovation networks. This initiative represents a new era of visibility and momentum for high-growth companies across Western New York, and Upstate as a whole as we look to expand up on this programming in 2026.

UVC also continued with its Founder Fusion events, which bring together entrepreneurs and emerging founders from Upstate NY with other networks and communities. These curated events are designed to foster meaningful connections and facilitate valuable discussions, bringing in top notch speakers including the co-founders of Wayfair, GLG, The Laundress, and more.


